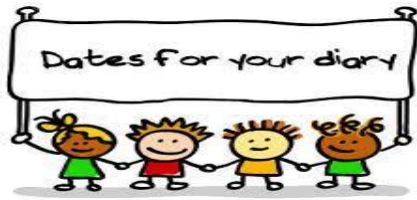
## LOST PROPERTY
