OLD POUND COINS

There are just nine days left until the old £1 coins cease to be legal tender and stores are no longer obliged to accept them.



But with more than £420m worth of old coins rattling around in coin jars, piggy banks and cars, consumers are being encouraged to find them and either use, exchange, or bank them before the October 15th deadline, after which only the new 12-sided £1 coins can be spent.

Any unspent £1 coins after 11:59 on October 15th can be traded in at banks, but this is only a temporary option – so it is a good idea to spend or exchange the coins now to avoid not being able to in future.

The Royal Mint said: "We would encourage you to spend, bank or donate your round £1 coins before October 15."

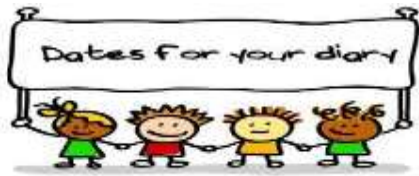
