FIREWORKS... BE SAFE NOT SORRY

Sparklers get five times hotter than cooking oil. A rocket can reach speeds of 150mph. A firework shell can reach as high as 200 metres. Three sparklers burning together generate the same heat as a blowtorch. The majority of firework-related injuries happen at family or private parties. Around half of all injuries are to children under the age of 17. The most common injuries are to hands, followed by the eyes and face. Be safe, be careful and enjoy Bonfire Night.
