### REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY

We wear the paper poppy as a symbol of Remembrance, to remember the fallen service men and women killed in conflict.



This year, the Royal British Legion are encouraging us to also see it as a symbol of hope, not just one of conflict.

Armistice Day, on Saturday November 11th, commemorates the signing of the armistice between the Allies and Germany at 11am on November 11, 1918.

There is a two minute silence held to mark the occasion - on the eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month - to remember those killed in the two World Wars and the 12,000 British servicemen killed or injured since 1945. The Armistice essentially ended four years of fighting in the World War I.
