## SEAT BELTS

One of the most important jobs you have as a parent is keeping your child safe when driving / riding in a vehicle. Twelve children under the age of ten are killed or injured as passengers every day. It has been the law since 1983 for all drivers and passengers to wear seatbelts. It has been noted that many parents are driving down Heathcote Street, without putting a seatbelt on their child. It is the responsibility of the driver to ensure adults and children under the age of 14 are restrained correctly. You can be issued with a penalty note of £100 or if it is taken to court you can be fined £500.
