NOROVIRUS – VOMITING BUG

If your child has diarrhoea in the morning, please *do not* send them into school. Inevitably you will receive a telephone call to take them home.



They are most infectious from when the symptoms start until 2 days after they've passed.

Try to avoid going to your GP, as the norovirus can spread to others very easily. Ensure they wash their hands regularly and stay off school until 48 hours after their last episode, to reduce the risk of passing it on. They should drink lots of water or squash to keep hydrated, take paracetamol to reduce a temperature and get plenty of rest.

We have had high numbers of both children and staff affected by sickness and diarrhoea during the last few weeks. Help us to keep our school germ free.

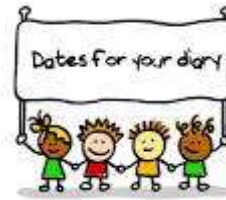
