## MAIN SCHOOL GATES

As you may have noticed over the last few days work has been carried out to the main school gates.

What this will mean for parents –

The pedestrian gate will be open until 9:00am for access to school, after this time they will be closed. To gain access to the school you will have to press the button/intercom on the gate which will put you through to the office and they will release the gate for you to PUSH, to exit the school you will need to press the button/intercom again and the office will release the gate for you PULL. Please ensure the gate closes behind you. The gate will be open again at 2:45pm for the end of day school collections.

The main vehicular gate will still be for staff and deliveries only.

There will be no changes to the Sadler Road entrance.

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## REQUESTS FOR HOLIDAY

Holidays in term time will not be granted. Under Government regulations, leave of absence can only be granted by the Headteacher in the case of exceptional circumstances and is for a maximum of 10 days. The leave must be authorised before any tickets are booked and where possible, be at least **4 weeks** before the beginning of the absence.

The decision to authorise absence rests with the school and once the decision is made, it is final.

If permission is granted photocopies of airline or travel tickets will be required by the school office before travelling.

If you decide to take your child out of school without the Headteacher's permission, the absence will be recorded as unauthorised and a Penalty Notice by the Children and Families First Team under S23 (1) of the Anti-Social Behaviour Act 2003 and Sections 444A and 444B of the Education Act 1996 will be issued and may result in a fine of up to £120.

If a child does not return to school, they may be taken off the school roll.
